

## Hamburg Community Garden Rules:

1. Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot. Watering, weeding, harvesting and any other garden related maintenance are all the responsibility of the gardener. Gardeners may arrange for other gardeners to water their plots.
2. Children are welcome in the garden but must be accompanied by an adult and must be supervised at all times.
3. Garden plots should be cared for at least once a week. It is the gardener's responsibility to notify the coordinator if he or she is not able to care for their plot in any given week. If any plot remains unattended for more than three weeks that plot is subject to reassignment.
4. Each gardener must complete a Release of all Claims form before any work in the garden can begin.
5. The application of toxic herbicides (weed killers) and pesticides to the garden plots is prohibited. Natural solutions for pests and weeds are acceptable.
6. Assignment of the garden plots is on a first come, first serve basis with payment in full. Preference for next year's plots will be given to this year's participants first.
7. Gardeners may harvest vegetables and flowers from their garden only.
8. No plants may be planted that are on the PA Noxious Weed list. Musk thistle, Nodding thistle, Canada thistle, Bull thistle, Spear thistle, Jimsonweed, goatsrue, giant hogweed, purple loosestrife, mile-a-minute, kudzu vine, multiflora rose, shattercane, & johnsongrass
9. The Garden Committee is responsible for ensuring that the rules are followed at all times.
10. If any of these rules are not followed individuals may be removed from their bed for the following season.
11. Garden hours are from sunrise to sunset.

\*\*Bring your own water pail. There will be no water on site until April, 2019
